PERU SCHOOL BOARD REACHING OUT TO COMMUNITY

Peru Central's Board of Education established four 'community-at-large' seats on the stakeholder committee that will interview second round candidates during March 2012 for the Superintendent of Schools position at Peru Central School District. This month, the school board is reaching out to the community and requests that individuals interested in filling one of the four 'community-at-large' seats express their interest by contacting the Peru Central School District Clerk Mrs. Sherri Provost at 643-6002 this month.

There will be twenty 'seats' on the school board's stakeholder committee. There will be **four seats filled by each of the following groups**: students selected by the high school student council, teachers selected by the Peru Association of Teachers, support staff selected by the CSEA bargaining unit, administrators selected by the Peru Administrative Council and the four 'community-at-large' seats to be filled by interested adults who reside within the boundaries of Peru Central yet are not employed by Peru Central. The stakeholder committee will be facilitated by Craig King, District Superintendent for Champlain Valley Educational Services.

The stakeholder committee is slated to meet Wednesday, February 15th for a 3:30 PM organizational meeting. Also, that stakeholder committee will meet several afternoons beginning at 3:30 PM during the week of Tuesday, March 27th.
