Peru HS offers a variety of programs and services for students with disabilities. Resource teachers provide remediation for skill deficits and supports for academics. Consultant teachers provide special education services within the regular education class setting. Teaching assistants also provide additional support in the regular education setting.

In the Work Study Program, students are given the opportunity to work on campus in the business offices, cafeterias and on the grounds at Peru. Students also gain valuable real life work experience volunteering at local businesses. In the classroom, students will be exposed to a life skills curriculum providing them with necessary ELA, math, health and social skills needed for a successful transition from school to the world of work.
