SCHOOL BOARD MEETS FEBRUARY 10TH IN COMMUNITY ROOM

Focus of regular monthly meeting includes Budget Development Workshop

Peru Central's Board of Education is set for the full range of monthly business at its regular meeting, Tuesday, February 10, 2009 at 6 PM at the community room, adjacent to the high school's main entrance. An executive session associated with collective bargaining and the performance history of particular employees will take place immediately following the 6 PM start. The school board is slated to reconvene for public session business at 7 PM. It's anticipated the school board will:

- Welcome the president of the student entrepreneurs club, as part of the monthly report on extra-curricular student activities, leadership development and service;
- Examine summary charts associated with the school district's fall 2008 first annual stakeholder perceptions surveys of students, parents, faculty and support staff.
- Adopt a formal resolution for the Governor and Legislature on maximizing school district resources by reducing the extraordinarily high level of mandates associated with various programs and services offered by New York State's school districts, as part of the evening's budget development workshop agenda;
- Discuss the eighth annual mid-year report on progress toward district goals this school year;
- Establish governing team representation at the May 2009 tenth annual Clinton County School Boards Association academic recognition dinner for the top ten percent of each school district's graduating class;
- Attend to the full range of monthly school district governance and finance matters.
