On the first day of camp, campers will report to the Peru Central High School Lobby at 8:30 am for registration. Walk-in registrations will be accepted, but please show up at 8:15 am on that day if you are not pre-registered. Please arrange for transportation home at 3:00 sharp Monday through Thursday and at 12:00 sharp on Friday. Mini-campers will be dismissed at 12:00 every day in the High School Lobby.
