On the first day of camp, campers will report to the Peru Central High School Lobby at 8:30 am for registration. Walk-in registrations will be accepted, but we ask that you please show up at 8:15 am to complete the registration. Please arrange for transportation home at 3:00 sharp Tuesday through Friday.

Each camp day has a thorough schedule filled with basketball instruction and other activities. At no point during the day are campers unsupervised or not engaged in camp. 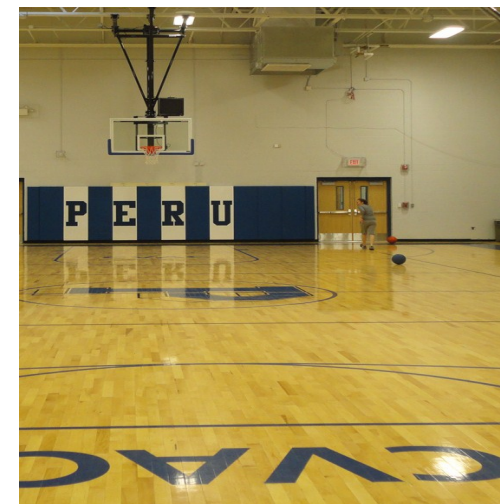
Big Blue Hoop Camp 2011
