

Grade 4 Homework Policy

Learning is not limited to the classroom. Homework is an essential part of the learning process, teaches students responsibility and organizational skills, and is a vital link between students, teachers and parents.

- Homework should last no more than 40 minutes.
- Parents should write the teacher a note if the student is unable to complete the work within the 40 minutes.
- The following steps will be used for ensuring that homework is successfully completed:
 - Step 1: Students who do not turn in homework on time will complete homework during recess and 10 points will be deducted from the score.
 - Step 2: If Step 1 has not been met with success, and the student does not complete the work, a grade of 50 will be given for the incomplete assignment.
 - Step 3: If a grade of 50 occurs twice in one quarter, parent contact will be made by the teacher.
