Bus Proposition No. 2

Shall the Board of Education of the Peru Central School District be authorized to purchase two (2) standard 65-passenger school buses, including related and ancillary equipment, at a maximum estimated cost of \$123,500 each, and one (1) wheelchair school bus, including related and ancillary equipment, at a maximum estimated cost of \$138,000, for a total aggregate maximum cost of \$385,000, and to raise the necessary funds therefor by a tax upon the taxable property of said District to be levied and collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board of Education shall determine, with such tax to be partially offset by State aid available therefor and, in anticipation of such tax, by either the issuance of debt obligations of the said School District or by a lease/purchase financing for such school buses, in either case in an amount not to exceed such estimated aggregate cost?
