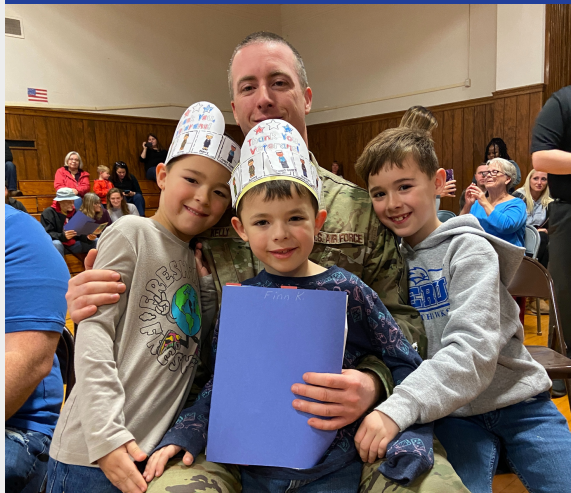

From the Principal's Desk

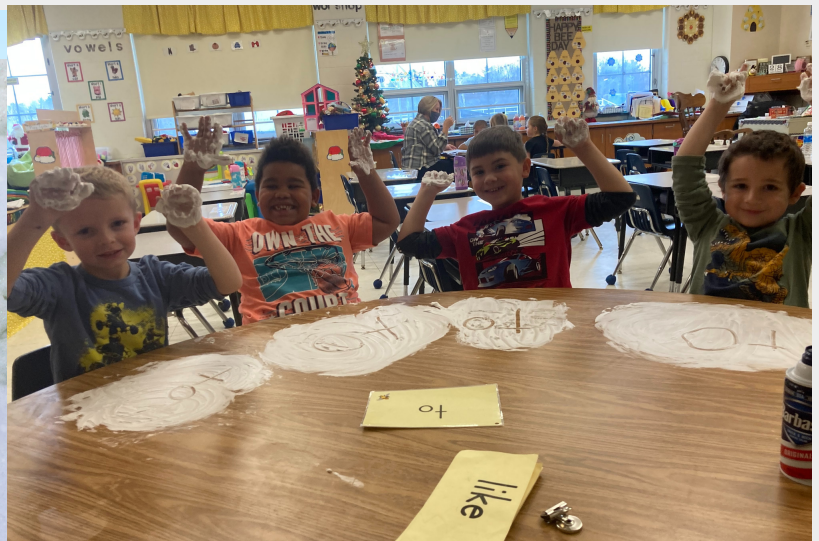

Dress like an elf and spread some holiday cheer!

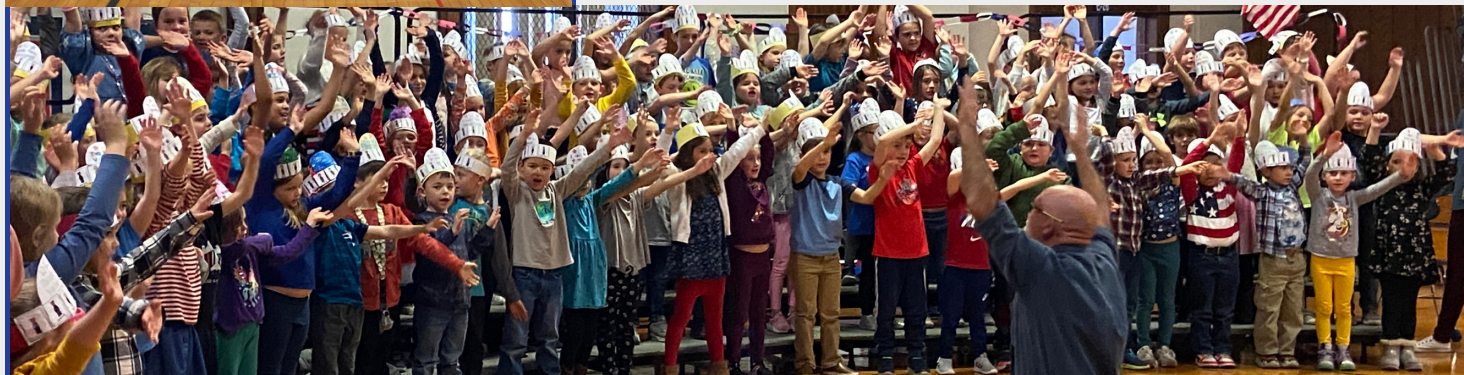
12/21 - Winter Solstice Day
