

Annual Asbestos Notification

Federal regulations require that schools be inspected for the presence of asbestos, a toxic material that has been used by the construction industry for a number of years. All Peru Central School buildings have been inspected for asbestos containing materials and the results of the inspection are contained in the Asbestos Management Plan. This plan has been sent to State authority in charge of asbestos abatement.

The asbestos management plan is available for review during regular working hours of the office of Facilities Director. A copy of the Asbestos Management Plan will be made on request for a nominal fee to cover the cost of copying and handling.

Recent scientific and medical evidence has shown that asbestos containing material can be harmful to the human body. The required surveillance is done every six months.
