

## School-Based Intervention Team

**Purpose:** To enable school personnel to meet the needs of individual students who are having difficulty in general education settings. The team's responsibilities include identifying academic and/or behavioral concerns that are interfering with school performance, brainstorming solutions, developing a plan to meet the student's needs, and to monitor/review the results of the recommendations.

    - Nurse completes form and submits directly to S-BIT facilitator
  - Completed S-BIT referral forms are submitted to building principal

  - SBIT Consultants - \*new\*
    - Consultants meet with the referring teacher prior to the S-BIT meeting to:
      1. Explain the purpose of the upcoming meeting: (fully understand student's needs, develop an evidence-based intervention plan for the student, set a goal for student improvement and select means to monitor the student's response to the intervention plan)
      2. Define the student referral concern(s) in clear, specific terms. The SBIT consultant reviews with the teacher the most important student referral concern(s), helping the teacher to define those concern(s) in clear, specific, observable terms. The teacher is also prompted to prioritize his or her top 1-2 student concerns.
      3. Ensure all needed data is brought to the SBIT meeting.
- S-BIT Meeting Agenda
