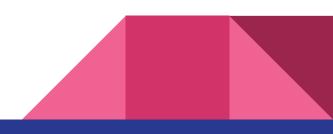

Year 1 Purchases 2018-2019

- Students in Grades 5, 6, 9, 10 will receive Chromebooks (approximate rollout date of January 2019)
 - Grade 5 will have class sets of computers that will be assigned to the teacher for student use and will not travel year to year with students.
 - Grade 6 devices will be assigned to the student through the completion of 8th grade.
 - \circ Grade 9 devices will be assigned to the student through the completion of 12th grade.
- Grade 5 and 6 classrooms will receive a laptop charging station
- Grade 2 will receive 6 iPads with cases per classroom, an instructional kit and an iPad charging station
- Upgrade one district computer lab with machines capable of running complex computer software.



Year 2 Purchases 2019-2020
