Phase 1: Smart Schools Investment Plan (Infrastructure and Security)

Phase 2: 2018-2019 Smart Schools Purchase Allocation

- Purchase 630 Chromebooks with protective cases for student devices
 - \$173,250.00
- 14 classroom laptop charging stations
 - \$7,000.00
- 42 iPads with Protective Cases Grade 2
 - \$14,000.00
- 6 classroom iPad charging stations
 - \$650.00
- Osmo iPad Instructional Kit for Grade 2
 - \$4200.00
- Full upgrade to one district computer lab
 - \$35,000.00



Phase 3: 2019-2020 Smart Schools Purchase Allocation

- Purchase 940 Chromebooks with protective cases for student devices
 - \$348,570.60
- 14 classroom laptop charging stations
 - \$14,000
- 84 iPads
 - \$28,160
- 12 classroom iPad charging stations
 - \$3,000
- Osmo iPad Instructional Kit for Grades K-1 (included OSMO designed iPad Cases)
 - \$8,500
- Full upgrade to two district computer lab
 - \$70,000
- AR/VR Kits for Intermediate, Middle and High School buildings.
 - \$51,000
- Classroom Displays
 - \$52,670



Phase 3 Purchases 2019-2020

- Students in Grades 3, 4, 6, 9, 11, 12 will receive Chromebooks (**approximate rollout date of January 2020**)
 - Grades 3 and 4 will have class sets of computers that will be assigned to the teacher for student use and will not travel year to year with students.
 - Grade 6 devices will be assigned to the student through the completion of 8th grade.
 - Grade 9 devices will be assigned to the student through the completion of 12th grade.
- Grade 3 and 4 classrooms will receive a laptop charging station
- Grades K and 1 will receive 6 iPads with cases per classroom, an instructional kit, and iPad charging station
- Upgrade two district computer lab's with machines capable of running complex computer software
- VR Kits for 3-12 classroom environments.
- Interactive classroom displays for grades K-1
