

AGES OF ATTENDANCE

New York State Education Law dictates that children ages 5-21 may attend the schools of the District in which their parents live. All children who are residents of the District are entitled to enrollment on a tuition-free basis in the public schools of the District until they receive a high school diploma.

Students who have received a high school diploma and are under 21 years of age may enroll in the schools of the District upon payment of tuition as set by the Board of Education on an annual basis, at the maximum rate for public school tuition allowed by law.
