ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

The Peru Central School District Board of Education sustains the non-resident student policy established 1997 and outlined below. The policy sustains long standing practice that nonresident students shall not be enrolled in the schools of Peru Central School District.

This policy shall supersede any and all prior policies and amendments thereto. However, it does not supersede the amendment adopted by the Board of Education on July 8, 1980, which provides that "children of employees who were hired prior to September 1, 1973, will be permitted to enroll in the Peru Central School District on a space available basis when they are not residents of the school district".

Resident Determinations

Determinations of residency shall be made in accordance with New York State Education Law and the Rules, Regulations and Procedures established by the Commissioner of Education.

Change of Student Residence During a School Year

In the event a student changes his/her residence and establishes a new residence outside the District during the course of any school year, the student shall be permitted to attend the schools of the District for the remainder of the marking quarter and shall be excluded from the District at the conclusion of the current marking quarter. The exception will be for students who will be seniors and the residency changes, the student will be permitted to attend the district and graduate. Such nonresident students shall not be charged tuition.

Exclusion of Continuing Nonresident Students

Continuing nonresident students may be denied admission to the schools of the District under the following circumstances:

In the event a continuing nonresident student, other than a senior, is suspended from instruction by the District based on misconduct, the student will no longer be permitted admission to the schools of the District as a continuing nonresident student and shall be excluded as of the date of suspension. A non-resident student in his or her senior year shall be disciplined in accordance with the Education Law and the District Code of Conduct.

In the event a continuing nonresident student registers and attends another school without advance authorization from the Superintendent of Schools of the District, the student will not be eligible for re-admission of the schools of the Peru Central School District as a continuing nonresident student and shall be denied admission upon application.
