

STUDENT SMOKING ON SCHOOL PREMISES

The Board of Education recognizes the health hazards associated with smoking.

Smoking or the use of tobacco-related products by students in school buildings, on school property or at school-sponsored activities is prohibited.

Students caught violating this policy will be subject to disciplinary penalties. The district's smoking policy shall be prominently posted in each building.

Restrictions on smoking and tobacco use are contained in both state and federal law.
