## FAQs About This Document

## What is the rationale used to develop this addendum to the reopening plan?

The Peru Central School District is adjusting the hybrid learning model to increase in-person contact time with students in all grades. It is our belief that increasing in-person instruction with students will have a direct and positive impact on our students both academically and emotionally. Students are currently grouped into A and B cohorts and attend 2 days per week of in-person instruction and 3 days working in an asynchronous model. In the adjusted model, Wednesdays will now be an in-person day that is rotated bi-weekly between the cohorts.

## When will the district bring all students back for five days of in person instruction?

This plan focuses on increasing instruction as phase one of full reopening. The district is in the process of analyzing the feasibility of fully reopening within the scope of all guidance currently available. This includes the impact on classroom space, transportation, availability of the required full remote option, and risk for COVID-19 exposure. As these plans are developed and timelines for implementation formalized, they will be shared with the public.

## What will the District's plans be for a Safety Compliance Officer?

A Safety Compliance Officer shall be designated by the Superintendent to be responsible for implementing, monitoring and enforcing all safety plans and policies. All employees shall be advised to direct all questions and concerns regarding the Plan to the Safety Compliance Officer. ## Who are the stakeholders of the Peru Central School District?

The stakeholder groups that were involved in the development and refinement of the reopening plans included the superintendent, the administrators, teacher union leadership and the community through a town hall meeting and surveys throughout the process.

## Spring Alternate Wednesday Model

This model will provide an increase in contact time that will occur in a shortened day of in-person instruction on Wednesdays. The students' instructional day will pause at the time of in person dismissal. Staff will use the remainder of the day to provide additional support, develop asynchronous materials and be available to follow up with fully remote students. Students will have an assignment to complete the school day upon returning home. Students will remain in their A \& B Cohorts. Wednesdays will alternate between Cohort A and B.

## Special Education Programs

Students receiving targeted Special Education programs (self-contained) have been receiving four days per week of in person instruction since the beginning of the school year. Students in integrated programs (co teacher \& consultant) have been receiving two days in person instruction. In some programs, a large number of our families have chosen the full remote option. In order to optimize programming for all of our students, some programs will remain in the two day option, some in the four day option and others will follow the five days of instruction, as outlined below. This information will be shared directly with impacted families.
